General Background Information

The Gold Rush A-Z public interface currently offers three different options for searching the system:

- 1. The Classic Interface (see Gold Rush Public Screens Classic)
- 2. The New Interface
- 3. The XML Gateway (see GRX Documentation)

The first two options are easy-to-use out-of-the-box interfaces which may be easily branded and modified inside the GR Staff Toolbox. The XML Gateway is a Web services layer for Gold Rush that requires a local library to write their own client but offers virtually unlimited possibilities for branding, design and local integration.

This section of the documentation is focusing on The New Interface which offers expanded and improved searching and viewing of a library's serials holdings. Library staff may easily switch between the Classic and New interface in the Gold Rush Staff Toolbox by simply selecting which viewing option is preferred (see page 4).

As with the Classic Interface, the New Interface fully interoperates with the other parts of the Gold Rush system including Gold Rush Linker (via the Article Finder Form), Incident Tracker (notices appear in the interface when problems are tracked), and Subscriptions (public display notes for contract terms and provisions).

The "Jump to" pull-down list offers the ability for libraries to easily jump around large lists of journals. Libraries may preselect how many journals are presented in a query in the Gold Rush Staff Toolbox. However, if more journals than this are retrieved in a query then the "Jump to" list appears.

Browsers

Gold Rush has been designed to work with current versions of all major browsers. Testing has been done to ensure compatibility with Mozilla Firefox, Internet Explorer, Google Chrome and Apple Safari. Other browsers may also work fine but have not been tested. There are slight differences in how the public interface appears with different browsers but full functionality is supported in each.


It is also recommended that pop-up blockers be allowed for the Gold Rush public interface.

About the New Public Interface


The new public interface in Gold Rush provides a cleaner and more simplified display of results. Result sets from a search prominently display key information such as journal title with an underlying link to database, issns and coverage dates. Indexing resources, subjects, alternate titles and a new option to pass a search through to other resources is under an "Additional Information" link. Repeat Search is an option in the new interface that supports searching the holdings of another Gold Rush library. Repeat Search replaces the "tabs" in the Classic interface.

To switch to the new public interface, go to Settings>Manage Preferences in the Gold Rush staff toolbox. This option is listed under "Search/Browse Results Display". Be sure to click the "update" button at the bottom of the screen to apply changes. Also, whenever any changes are made in "Settings" to the public interface, be sure to "Exit" a current search session for changes to properly appear in the public interface.

NOTE: After changing from the classic interface to the new one, you may notice some additional search targets or have questions about targets that appear in the "Repeat Search" drop down list, contact the CO Alliance for assistance. Or, refer to page 24 of the "Settings" documentation (Manage Targets and Proxy Server).




Journal Search Results Page



Article FinderCitation form pop-up window.




Additional information

Expands to include indexing resources, alternate titles and subjects. After opening, click Additional Information to close section.

Click on link for indexing alternate tiles or subjects and section will expand to display resources. If there are no resources screen will indicate "none".

Repeat Search

The Repeat Search option allows you to search other Gold Rush libraries, or set up searches into other resources such as the library catalog or interlibrary loan. The box will not appear if no other Gold Rush libraries are selected to search or there are no pre-selected search targets.




To set up a search to another Gold Rush library, select Settings>Manage Preferences>Default Libraries from the Gold Rush staff toolbox. Check the box next to the library name you would like to search. You can select multiple check boxes. Be sure to click the "Update" button at the bottom of the screen to apply changes.



Look for this Journal

The "look for this journal" drop down box appears under "Additional Information" in the public interface. Pre-constructed targets to the library catalog, Interlibrary loan or other resources will appear in the drop down box. When a specific target is selected from the drop down box, the search is launched at the journal record level so the search is on a specific ISSN or specific journal title. If you haven't configured targets in the "Settings" area, the "Look for this journal" box will not display on screen.







Journal Subjects Search




Pull down to navigate to another journal in list
